Swimming Lessons

NSW Education Parent App

The Department of Education has launched an exciting new digital communication tool, the NSW Education Parent App to help support good school-home communication.

The app already has 180,000 users and is a convenient way our school can keep you up to date with latest news, school updates, newsletter, school operational status and upcoming events which you can add to your personal calendar.

You can choose to receive instant notifications when there is an update from the school and access the same content that's on our school website in an accessible way when you are on the go.

The app has advanced privacy and security features and won't store any identifying data. It is free and available for iOS and Android users so you can download the NSW Education Parent App in the Apple Store or Google Play.

Once you download the app, you will need to complete the onboarding process in the Parent App to select the school(s) you'd like to follow and enable your push notifications in your phone's settings and in the app's School Settings to make sure you never miss and important update.

Mosquito Repellent

The Department of Education has supplied the school with Red Eyed Gotcha! Personal insect repellent (atomiser pump).

Active constituents:

- 191g/L Nm N-Diethylm-m-toluamide (DEET)
- 40g/L N-octyl bicychloheptene dicarboximide
- 20g/L Di-n-propyl isocinchomeronate
- 1g/L Triscolan

If your child is allergic to any of these ingredients, or you do not want the repellent applied, please contact the school.

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
