

#### **Pioneer Park Excursion Year 3-6**


The Year 3-6 Excursion to Pioneer Park will take place on Thursday 23 November.

Thank you to those families who have ordered books throughout the year - a proportion of the sales returns to the school and this helps with purchasing new books for our library.




Goolgowi Public School P&C are appealing for donations for our upcoming Christmas Hamper Raffle. We would be very grateful if you could assist by donating towards this.




