Lochie did extremely well winning the 11 Year Old Boys discus, second in the 100 metre dash, second in the 200 metre dash and second in the shot put. He was also awarded 11 Year Old Boys Champion for the carnival.

Reagan also did well and came second in her event, the Girls 8-10 years 1500 metre run.


3-6 News






