Tell Them From Me Survey

The Tell Them From Me student survey asks students about a range of school experiences, including their engagement and wellbeing at school and beyond. It also asks students about teaching practices and the learning environment.

The survey takes about 20 minutes to complete and it is for students in Years 4, 5 and 6.

Explaining the survey to your child

- Your child (Year 4, 5 & 6) will be filling out an online survey called 'Tell Them From Me'.
- This survey is an opportunity for them to let their teachers know how they are going at school.
- The survey will ask your child how engaged they are with their learning, different ways that their teachers teach them in class, how supported they feel at school, and more.
- Your child's responses are confidential, which means their teachers won't know how they have answered.
- Please encourage your child to answer as honestly as they can. There are no right or wrong answers. The school just wants to hear what they think and their

responses will help to improve their school. Some of the questions are there to help the school understand students and how to best meet their needs.

- If your child is unsure how to answer them, they can skip these questions.
- They can skip any question that they don't feel comfortable answering.
- If your child would like to talk about any of the questions in this survey, please encourage them to talk to their teacher or parents.

If you do not wish your child to participate in Tell Them From Me, complete a **nonconsent form** and send it to your school. There is also more information on the Department's website and by clicking the link.

Orientation Program & Parent Information Sessions

Goolgowi Public School's Kindergarten Orientation program begins in Week 1 Term 4 and **all of our 2023 Kindergarten students must be enrolled beforehand to participate in the orientation program** so I encourage parents to enrol their child this term. This gives our future students a chance to become familiar with the school and assists us to plan our classes.

The Department of Education requires that:

- all children must be in compulsory schooling by their 6th birthday.
- children can start Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five on or before 31 July that year.
- students should start school at the beginning of the school year.

Once they have completed the online enrolment, parents are asked to bring into the office:

- the child's birth certificate or identity documents.
- proof of child's address (For example: current council rates notice, residential lease, electricity bill).

- immunisation history statement from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).
- any family law or other relevant court orders, if applicable.




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
