Below 80% attendance raises levels of concern for your child's learning and equates to two months off school. We understand that there are circumstances where days off school are needed and unavoidable. However, high rates of attendance support students with a sense of belonging, fosters strona connections with their teachers and peers and supports and enhances student learning.

Kindergarten 2024

Orientation Program & Parent Information Sessions

Goolgowi Public School's Kindergarten Orientation program begins in Week 1 Term 4 and all of our 2023 Kindergarten students must be enrolled beforehand to participate in the orientation program so I encourage parents to enrol their child this term. This gives our future students a chance to become familiar with the school and assists us to plan our classes.

The Department of Education requires that:

- all children must be in compulsory schooling by their 6th birthday.
- children can start Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five on or before 31 July that year.
- students should start school at the beginning of the school year.

Once they have completed the online enrolment, parents are asked to bring into the office:

- the child's birth certificate or identity documents.
- proof of child's address (For example: current council rates notice, residential lease, electricity bill).
- immunisation history statement from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).
- any family law or other relevant court orders, if applicable.



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


Classroom News
