Kindergarten 2024

Orientation Program & Parent Information Sessions

Goolgowi Public School's Kindergarten Orientation program begins in Week 1 Term 4 and all of our 2023 Kindergarten students must be enrolled beforehand to participate in the orientation program so I encourage parents to enrol their child this term. This gives our future students a chance to become familiar with the school and assists us to plan our classes.

The Department of Education requires that:

- all children must be in compulsory schooling by their 6th birthday.
- children can start Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five on or before 31 July that year.
- students should start school at the beginning of the school year.

Once they have completed the online enrolment, parents are asked to bring into the office:

- the child's birth certificate or identity documents.
- proof of child's address (For example: current council rates notice, residential lease, electricity bill).
- immunisation history statement from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).
- any family law or other relevant court orders, if applicable.

NSW Bushfire Danger Period 2023/24

The Bushfire Danger Period (BFDP) is from 1 October until 31 March each year.

The fire danger ratings are as follows:



Goolgowi Public School has been rated as being in a Category 1 area. This means that the school is in a bushfire prone area and has an extreme landscape-to-site bushfire risk. The school will need to proactively temporarily cease school operations when a catastrophic fire danger rating is issued by the Bureau of Meteorology or in line with local arrangements.

The School safety website (https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/school-safety) and the NSW School Education Parents app provide parents and the school community with up-to-date information on all adverse weather conditions.

If the event of the school needing to close, parents will be advised via SchoolBytes, email, Facebook and telephone.



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


